The children were animated about what they saw when they recalled their day back in school. During forest school the children were busy identifying trees by observing their leaves closely. They successfully identified lots of the trees that we are lucky to have on site. As the term end nears, the children have been playing with the toys and using their equipment as well as being busy sorting, cleaning and getting it ready for the children next term. Mrs Wealthy has been teaching the children new woodwork skills as they make wooden models using hammers and nails too.
