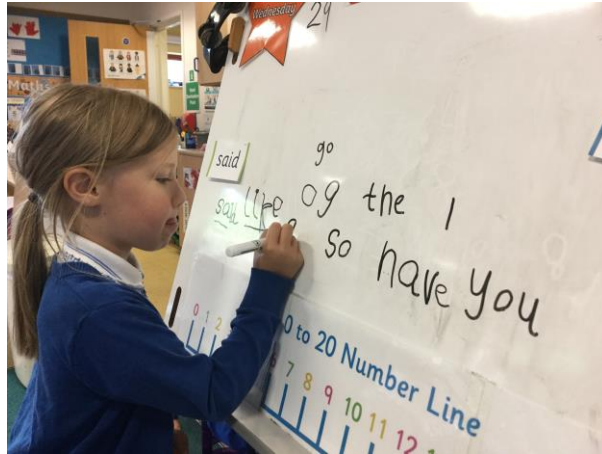


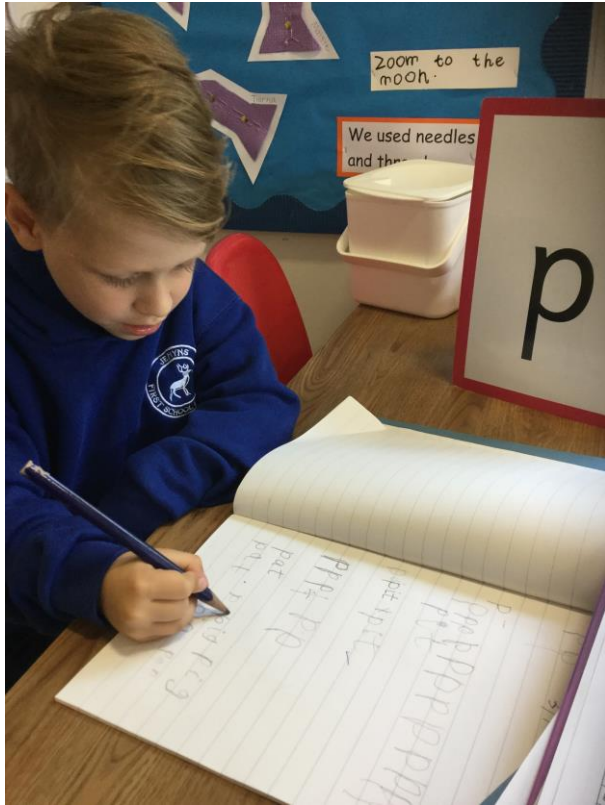


## Class 1

We were really proud of all the children competing in sports day yesterday and their sportmanship towards each other, it was really great to see how kind and supportive they were towards their peers.









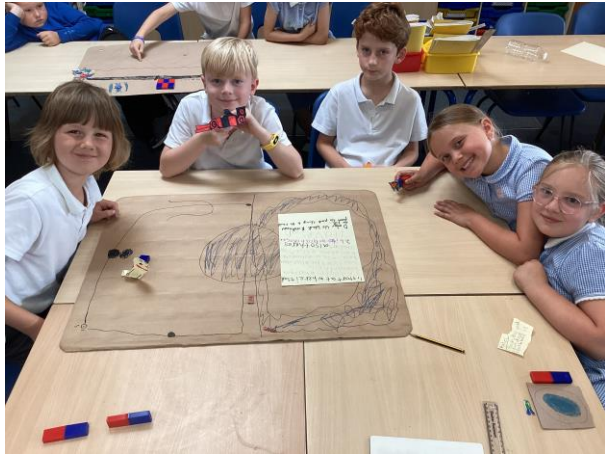


### Class 3
