





<p>English</p> <p>This half term we will be starting with a narrative unit based on a book by Roald Dahl called 'The Minpins'. Within this unit they will be writing danger posters, setting descriptions, character descriptions, information reports and postcards. The final piece will be their own version of an adventure story.</p> <p>Next they will focus on 'The dragon Machine' by Helen Ward. They will write dragon guides & encyclopaedia, letters of advice, dragon machine explanations, shopping lists and descriptions, letters. The final piece will be their own version of a dragon story.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This half term the children will be learning about multiplication and division. They will begin by learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Then they will look at grouping amounts and recognising equal groups and unequal groups. They will explore arrays and make own arrays. They will then look at learning the 2x, 5x and 10x tables and associated division facts.</p> <p>The children will also be learning how measure and compare length and heights in centimetres and metres.</p> 	<p>Science</p> <p>During this unit of work, children will learn about different scientist's and their inventions.</p> <p>In Science week we will be linking World book day with our science – reading Aliens love underpants. We will then be exploring which type of pants soak up the most water looking at different materials. We will also make a catapult to investigate how far the pant will travel and which type will travel the furthest.</p> <p>We will also be looking at describing the importance of hygiene to humans in the context of investigating Louis Pasteur's work on how germs spread. Also we will find out about people who have developed new materials in the context of learning about Charles Macintosh.</p>	<p>Phonics and Spelling, punctuation & grammar</p> <p>Year 1</p> <p>Continue to learn new phase 5 graphemes including new graphemes that make previously learnt sounds</p> <p>Year 2</p> <p>Review spelling patterns learnt in Y1 as well as common exception words and homophones as well as plurals and irregular plurals.</p>	<p>Art- Sculpture</p> <p>Within this unit the children will have the opportunity to explore architecture. We start with an exploration of architects and some of the ways they work, and pupils then go on to create their own architectural model.</p>  <p>DT- textiles</p> <p>The children will practise sewing skills when they design and make a dragon puppet which links to one of our English texts.</p>
<p>History- What were our schools like?</p> <p>Within this unit the children will find out what school was like back to the 1900's and compare to school today.</p> 	<p>Year group: 1 and 2 YEAR B Term: Spring 2</p>  			<p>Music- On this Island: British songs and sounds</p> <p>In this unit the children will learn to sing a selection of songs. They will create symbols to represent sounds and develop and perform a musical composition.</p> 
<p>Computing – Data handling – ISS station</p> <p>In this unit children will develop confidence with the keyboard and the basics of touch typing, create and label images. They will learn how to collect and input data into a spreadsheet and be able to interpret data from a spreadsheet. They will also look at how computers are used in the wider world.</p>	<p>PE- Invasion games</p> <p>They will develop their understanding of defending and attacking.
